How are we encouraging social distancing and a safe camp environment?

All camps will be following the recommendations of the CDC and ACA which include:

- Camps will be limited to 12 students per class in order to ensure space between students
- · Restrict mixing between groups of students
- Limiting nonessential visitors and volunteers
- Keep each child's belongings separated from others'
- Ensure adequate supplies to minimize sharing of high-touch materials as much as possible
- Limit use of supplies and equipment by one group of children at a time and clean and disinfect between use.
- Restrooms and other surfaces children regularly contact shall be sanitized with a disinfectant effective against coronavirus on a regular schedule and between groups occupying a particular area.

What is the STAR Rep doing to reduce the spread of germs?

In order to do so we will be abiding by our consistent procedures recommended by the CDC to prevent the spread of colds and flus daily.

- Ensuring hand washing supplies are well stocked and accessible for camp participants, staff and volunteers
- Increasing hand sanitizer dispenser stations placed throughout the STAR Rep Building. Every camper must santize before they enter, and after they leave the STAR Rep Building
- Taking every camper, staff and volunteer's temperature with a non-touch therometer
- Increasing the frequency of disinfecting sprays/wipes to sanitize frequently touched surfaces (doorknobs, light switches, bathrooms, chairs, tables, etc.)
